Off-licence



Sections 17 to 20, and 64, Sale and Supply of Alcohol Act 2012

PURSUANT to the Sale and Supply of Alcohol Act 2012 (the Act), Forager Wine Limited (the Licensee) is authorised to sell from the premises situated at 5 John Leith Place, Leithfield, and known as Forager Wine", to any person for consumption off the premises.

ENDORSEMENT

Section 40 of the Act applies to this licence; and the licensee is authorised to sell alcohol from (but not on) the premises and deliver it somewhere else.

The authority conferred by this licence must be exercised through a manager or managers appointed by the licensee in accordance with Subpart 7 of Part 2 of the Act.

CONDITIONS

This licence is subject to the following conditions:

- (a) No alcohol is to be delivered on Good Friday, Easter Sunday, Christmas Day or before 1.00 pm on Anzac Day.
- (b) Alcohol may be sold only on the following days and during the following hours:

 A remote sale of alcohol can be made at any time on any day but is subject to the restrictions on delivery. The holder of an off-licence must ensure that any alcohol sold by remote sale is not delivered to the buyer (or any other person on the buyer's behalf) at any time after 11pm on any day and before 6am on the next day.
- (c) The licensee must have the website checked for compliance by a member of the Licensing team at Hurunui District Council before it becomes operational for remote sales.

Subject to the requirements of the Act relating to the payment of fees, and to the provisions of the Act relating to the suspension and cancellation of licences, the licence expires on:

8th day of October 2022
